

Sub: Registration on the "Yoga Sangam" portal for the International Day of Yoga, 2026 (21st June) – participation by all Departments.

Sir / Madam,

As you are aware that, the International Day of Yoga is observed across the nation and the world on the 21st of June each year. In connection with its observance in the year 2026, the Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, has launched the "Yoga Sangam" portal to facilitate the registration of mass yoga demonstrations and group participation events throughout the country.

All Departments are accordingly requested to register on the portal and to extend their wholehearted participation. The salient features of the portal are set out below for ready reference:

1. The portal — yoga.ayush.gov.in/yoga-sangam — is the official registration portal for the International Day of Yoga, 2026.
2. It follows a five-stage registration process, comprising (i) Organisation details, (ii) Contact details, (iii) OTP verification, (iv) Venue registration, and (v) Other details.
3. On successful registration, the organisation receives an email containing a reference ID, which is to be retained for downloading the e-certificate after the event held on 21st June.
4. The registration process is concise and user-friendly. The portal records the geo-location of the venue, and participants may upload photographs and feedback of the event held at their respective locations.
5. There is no registration fee. Communities, institutions and the general public may participate freely in the event.
6. For the purpose of recording individual participation, each participant is advised to register through his or her own mobile telephone or computer.

In view of the foregoing, all Departments, together with their attached and subordinate offices and the autonomous bodies and undertakings under their administrative control, are requested to complete registration on the portal at the earliest, to organise yoga demonstrations on the 21st of June, 2026, and to ensure the widest possible participation of officers, members of staff and the public at large.

The observance of the day in a befitting manner may kindly be accorded due priority, and compliance ensured.
